

## Dogs on Weymouth Beach

Dogs are not permitted on Weymouth Beach and Greenhill Beach from Good Friday to 31st October (inclusive). There is a dog area all year round at the Pavilion end of the beach and all of Preston Beach (beyond the rock groyne). Assistance dogs from the charities below are exempt from this restriction as long as they are being used for their prescribed purpose:

- Dogs for the Disabled (registered charity number 700454)
- Support Dogs (registered charity number 1088281)
- Canine Partners for Independence (registered charity number 803680)

From 1st November until Maundy Thursday (inclusive) dogs are permitted anywhere on the beach and do not have to be on a leash unless instructed to by an authorised officer. Please remember that dogs need to be under effective voice control and remain in sight. You still need to carry a leash. Don't forget to take poop scoops so you can pick up any mess.

- Always keep your dog leashed when required (dogs should always be kept on a leash along the promenade, max length 2m)
- Always clean up after your dog and dispose of mess into any public litter bin
- Do not let your dog approach other beach users or dogs, unless welcomed
- If off leash your dog needs to be well-behaved, must listen to your verbal commands and it must remain within your sight
- Always consider other beach users
