

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST LEONARDS'S ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along St Leonard's Road, Weymouth between Newberry Gardens and Newberry Road, a distance of approximately 70 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 9 September 2019, between 09:30hrs and 15:30hrs and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on the 9 September 2019. This notice is valid for a maximum of 5 days.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out urgent work on a collapsing pipe in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows:
Newberry Gardens - Herbert Place - Franchise Street.
