

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIDEN STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along MAIDEN STREET, WEYMOUTH between Market Street and Bond Street, a distance of approximately 100 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 9th September 2019 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11th September 2019.

This Notice will enable SSE safe access to carry out a road crossing for a new electricity supply in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Bond Street - The Esplanade - Custom House Quay - St Mary Street - St Edmund Street - Maiden Street.
