This application is for Police Officers and Staff to become qualified football coaches and deliver 1 week long football camps at 3 hours per day during half term, Easter and other school holidays. The aim is to engage with youths who are known or suspected of involvement in criminality and anti-social behaviour, providing a positive focus for them, rewarding achievement and good behaviour, building their confidence in contact with the police and a sense of social responsibility.

This diversion scheme will have a positive and memorable influence on its participants and also benefit the wider community by reducing crime and anti- social behaviour more generally.

The initial funding would provide training for officers, provide the training kit and equipment to run the training sessions and rewards for camp participants.
