

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 130, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along Footpath 130, from grid reference SY 663 786 (Point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 662 784 (Point B on the map below), a distance of approximately 380 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 1 October 2020 for a period of 26 weeks but it will remain in force for 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This closure is required to allow construction of domestic housing.

Alternative Route: From point A grid ref SY 663 786 turn south along footpath 130 to point C grid ref SY 666 786. Then go along Chickerell Road to point D grid ref SY 667 861. Then turn southwards along Markham Avenue on to footpath 79, walk along footpath 79 and footpath 92 to point B SY 662 784
