

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PLAISTERS LANE, SUTTON POYNTZ

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along PLAISTERS LANE, SUTTON POYNTZ between Sutton Court Lawns and Longmead, a distance of approximately 300 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 1 February 2022 between 0930 and 1530 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 February 2022.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to carry out pole testing.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Sutton Road - Preston Road - Littlemoor Road - Coombe Valley Road - Plaisters Lane
