

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH BETWEEN JUBILEE CLOSE & KING STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along FOOTPATH BETWEEN JUBILEE CLOSE & KING STREET, WEYMOUTH between Jubilee Close and King Street, a distance of 100 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 18 March 2022 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 March 2022.

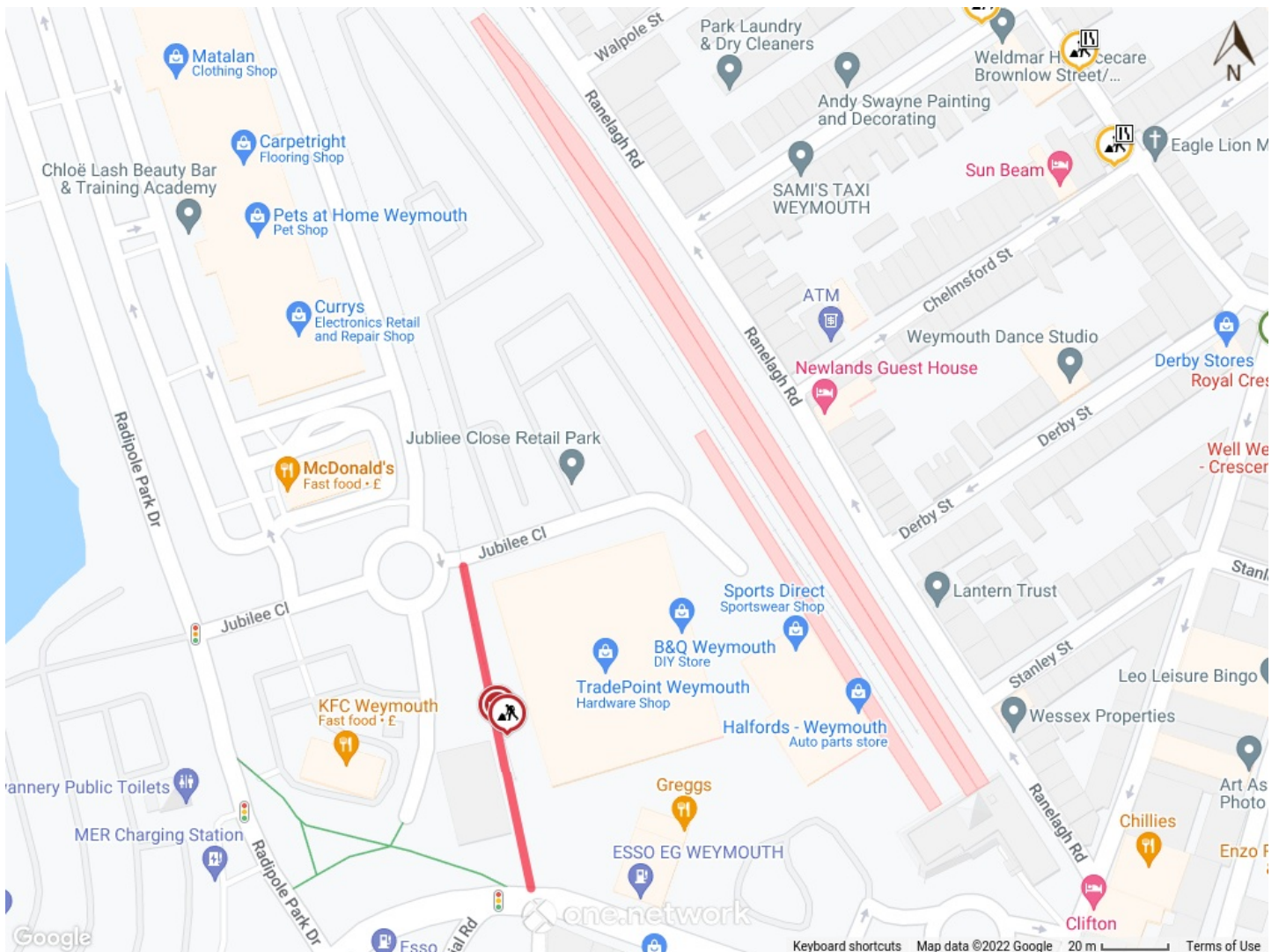
This Order will enable Dorset Council safe access to carry out improvement works associated with Pocket Park.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable pedestrians to travel around the closed sections.
