

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF BROWNLOW STREET, WEYMOUTH FOR A STREET PARTY FOR HM THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Sunday 5 June 2022 between 12:00 and 18:00.

The effect of this Notice is as follows;

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on Brownlow Street between no's 1 & 16
- [2] To impose temporary parking restriction on Brownlow Street between no's 1 & 16

On this occasion there will be no alternative route.
