

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF BRUNSWICK TERRACE, WEYMOUTH FOR A STREET PARTY FOR HM THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Saturday 4 June 2022 between 10:00 and 22:00.

To impose temporary road closure and parking suspension on Brunswick Terrace from its junction with the link road from the Esplanade to the end of the cul-de-sac.

There will be no alternative route signed for traffic on this occasion.
