

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF ST NICHOLAS STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 12 June 2022 between 0800 and 1700 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 June 2022.

This Notice will enable LTS Group safe access to remove refrigeration cases from Tesco.

The effect of this Notice is as follows;

[1] To impose temporary road closure on ST NICHOLAS STREET, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Lower St Alban Street and Lower St Edmund Street, a distance of approximately 50 metres.

[2] To revoke the pedestrian zone order on Lower St Alban Street & St Thomas Street to allow access for diverted traffic.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Lower St Alban Street - St Thomas Street - North Quay - A354 Westway Road - B3155 Swannery Bridge - Commercial Road
