

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHAFEYS AVENUE, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along CHAFEYS AVENUE, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Radipole Lane and The Rise a distance of 25 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 10 October 2022 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 November 2022.

This Order will enable Cara Construction safe access to carry out works associated with drainage connections.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: The Rise - Field Barn Drive - Radipole Lane
