

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ESSEX ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ESSEX ROAD, WEYMOUTH, a distance of approximately 30 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 26 September 2022 between 0930 and 1530 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 September 2022.

This Notice will enable Jurassic Fibre Limited safe access to carry out works in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Abbotsbury Road - Newstead Road - Milton Road
