

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, LENNOX STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Notice comes in to operation on 3 October 2022 between 0930 and 1530 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 October 2022.

This Notice will enable Openreach to facilitate the use of temporary traffic signals.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[1] To impose temporary parking suspension on Lennox Street between its junction with Melcombe Place and its junction with the mini roundabout for a distance of approximately 20 metres as indicated by signs on site.
