

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUDDLEDOCK LANE, SUTTON POYNTZ

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along PUDDLEDOCK LANE, SUTTON POYNTZ from its junction with Sutton Road for a distance of approximately 60 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 5 October 2022 between 0930 and 1530 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 October 2022.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to accommodate CCTV surveying and cleaning of sewer assets.

On this occasion there will be no alternative route. Access will be maintained for residents.
