

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST ALBAN STREET/NEW STREET, WEYMOUTH (NIGHT WORKS)

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ST ALBAN STREET/NEW STREET, WEYMOUTH; St Alban Street between its junctions with Maiden Street and New Street; New Street from no. 3 to its junction with St Alban Street. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 19 September 2022 until 21 September 2022 and remain in force for five days. Works to be carried out overnight between 20:00 and 06:00.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to carriageway to clear blockage.

On this occasion there will be no alternative route.
