

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WATERY LANE, UPWEY, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along WATERY LANE, UPWEY, WEYMOUTH between its junction with Stottingway Street and its junction with the access road to Wey Valley Farm, a distance of 510 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 3 January 2023 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 February 2022.

This Order will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace water main.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Stottingway Street - Dorchester Road - Mill Street - Watery Lane
