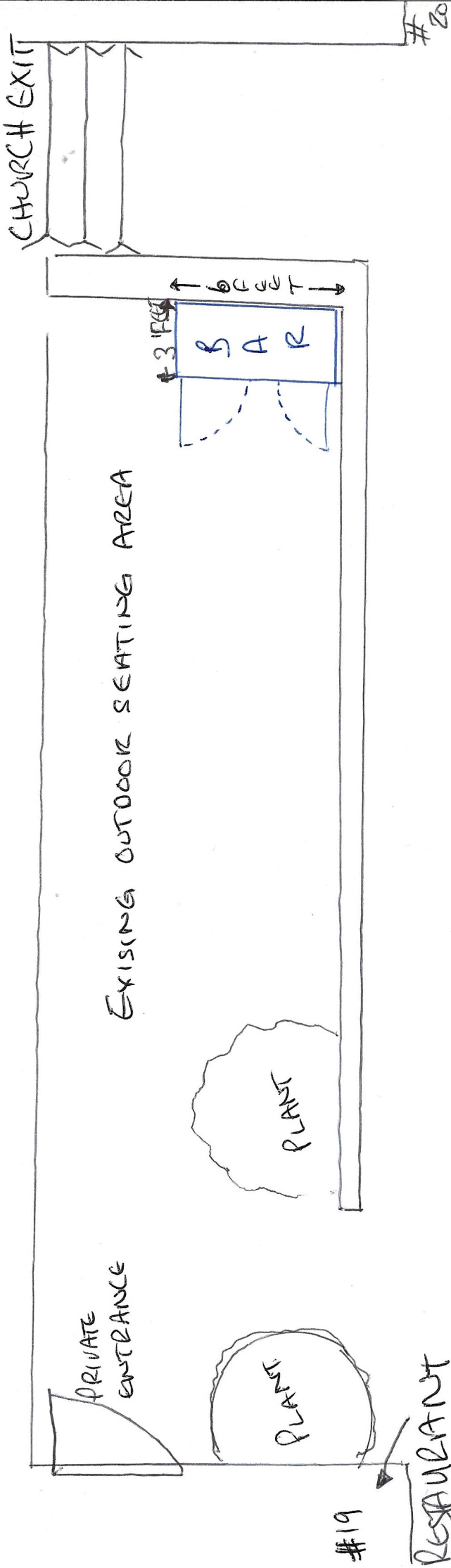

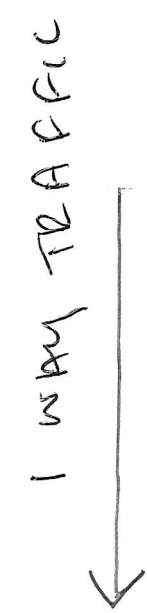
Notes for Guidance
