

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ELWELL STREET, UPWEY, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ELWELL STREET, UPWEY, WEYMOUTH between its junction with Church Street and the access to the public footpath, a distance of 370 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 5 February 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 February 2024.

This Order will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out sewer renovation works to prevent infiltration.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3159 - Stottingway Street - Dorchester Road
