

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ABBOTSBURY ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ABBOTSBURY ROAD, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Alma Road and B3154, a distance of approximately 1170 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 15 July 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 July 2024 between 2000hrs and 0500hrs. Please note that access to all the side roads will be managed by operatives on site.

This Order will enable RMS and WJ Lining to carry out asphalt preservation and lining works.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A354 - B3157 - B3158 - Chickerell Road
