

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RODWELL STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along RODWELL STREET, WEYMOUTH for its entirety. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 16 December 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 December 2024.

This Notice will enable NPB Utilities safe access to excavate and install new water connection.

On this occasion there will be no alternative route.
