

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF CUSTOM HOUSE QUAY, WEYMOUTH FOR QUAYSIDE MUSIC FESTIVAL - LATE MAY BANK HOLIDAY 2025

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Saturday 24 May 2025 at 0600hrs until Sunday 25 May 2025 at 2359hrs, the following restrictions will be imposed;

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on Custom House Quay between underneath the town lifting bridge and its junction with St Mary Street.
- [2] To suspend the parking bays on Custom House Quay between underneath the town lifting bridge and its junction with St Mary Street.
- [3] To impose temporary closure on the South-west coast path at the steps between the Town Bridge and Custom House Quay
- [4] To impose temporary closure on the side alleyway between Marlboro Chip shop and The Anchor

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be via: Lower St Alban Street - St Thomas Street
