

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH FOR WESSEX FOLK FESTIVAL 2025

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to restrict the use of Various Roads, Weymouth by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles.

On Friday 30 May 2025 at 20:00 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 12:00 or as otherwise indicated by signs on site.

The effect of this Notice is as follows;

- To impose temporary road closure on Trinity Road for its entirety at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To impose temporary road closure on Cove Street for its entirety at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To impose temporary road closure on Hope Square for its entirety at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To impose temporary road closure on Cove Row for its entirety at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To revoke the No Entry Order at Spring Road/Horsford Street to allow access for residents at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To revoke the No Entry Order on Trinity Street for its entirety to allow access for residents at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To impose temporary parking suspension on all spaces adjacent to the Trinity Road Sand Jetty at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- To impose temporary parking suspension on the remainder of Trinity Road and all of Cove Row at 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
- Zone L permit holders will be permitted to park in the Nothe Car Park at no extra charge between 2000hrs on Friday 30 May 2025 until Monday 2 June 2025 at 1200hrs
