

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NIGHTINGALE DRIVE, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along NIGHTINGALE DRIVE, WEYMOUTH between no. 8 Nightingale Drive and its junction with Brambling Close, a distance of approximately 25 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 15 July 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 July 2025.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to excavate and provide new ducting in carriageway & footway to provide service to customer.

On this occasion there will be no alternative route.
