

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE OF VARIOUS STREETS, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 6 August 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 August 2025.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to install new connection in the highway.

The effect of the Notice will be:

[1] To impose temporary road closure on Maiden Street between its junctions with St Alban Street and Bond Street

[2] To impose temporary no left turn on St Alban Street at its junction with Maiden Street

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Mitchell Street - East Street - The Esplanade
