

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST THOMAS STREET, WEYMOUTH - NIGHT WORKS

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ST THOMAS STREET, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with School Street and St Edmund Street, a distance of approximately 330 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 13 August 2025 between 1900 and 2330 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 August 2025.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out remedial defect in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: **From the North:** School Street - St George Street - Westham Road - The Esplanade - Pilgrims way - Custom House Quay - St Mary Street - St Edmund Street **From the West:** St Nicholas Street - Custom House Quay - St Marys Street - St Edmund Street
